

19th PUBLIC SECTOR TRAINERS' FORUM (PSTF) CONFERENCE

The Strategic Human Capital Development unit in the Office of the Premier, led a provincial delegation of 25 officials made up of Senior Managers, managers as well as practitioners to the 19th National Public Sector Trainer's Forum (PSTF) Conference held at the Gallagher Convention Center in Midrand, Gauteng Province. The conference was held on the 16 - 18 October 2017.

PSTF is an annual conference that affords HRD practitioners and manager's the opportunity to reflect critically on their role in the context of building a capable and developmental State. This year's conference amongst others dealt with the policy environment, capacity development and career pathing: existing models and systems. The conference was held in partnership with the European Union who pledged **£10m** towards a Capacity Building Development Programme that will be coordinated by the National School of Government.
